### **PHILOSOPHY**

*S.E.E.K. grants scholarships to students of financial need and to students who will make a contribution to and benefit from a private school education.*

### **CRITERIA FOR GRANTING SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Students receive assistance based upon financial need. The Scholarship Committee takes into account the number of dependents in a family, the expenses for all siblings' education, all sources of income, debts, etc.
- Renewal of a scholarship is based upon proof of continued financial need, as well as evidence that the recipient has exhibited academic progress and good citizenship. New forms and tax returns must be submitted each year.
- Those reapplying for financial assistance are given priority. Then, consideration is given to those seeking aid for the first time.
- In the case of divorced or separated parents, both natural parents must submit an Application for Financial Assistance. Both parents send copies of their last two tax returns. If information from both parents is not available at the time the application is evaluated, it may cause an arbitrary assessment of financial need. This may result in a lesser award or no award at all.
- In addition to financial need, the Committee awards scholarships based upon the availability of funds.
- If you do not enroll in the school as defined on the application, the Committee will cancel the scholarship award.
